DIRECTIONS:

For use with steam cleaners and pressure washers with adjustable feed systems:

Set equipment to draw product directly from container at lowest feed rate. If more cleaning power is needed, adjust feed rate accordingly. At optimum use, product foam should break in 45 to 60 seconds.

For use with steam cleaners and pressure washers without adjustable feed systems:

Set equipment to draw product directly from container. If that concentration is too great, dilute the product concentrate with 10-25 parts water before drawing it through the equipment. At optimum use, foam should break in 45 to 60 seconds.

DIRECTIONS: (continued)

Hand Held Hosemaster Sprayer: Fill chemical bottle with product. Unit automatically dilutes at preset rates.

For bucket-and-brush operations: Dilute product with water at a rate of 32:1 for general cleaning...5:1 for heavy soils including wheels, bumpers, etc.

When cleaning vertical surfaces, apply the product solution to the dry surface, working from the bottom to the top. When rinsing, work from the top down. Hold the spray wand 3-6 inches (7-15 cm) from surface when pressure washing.

Adjust contact time, agitation and concentration as needed to maximize cleaning results.

EMERGENCY FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

EYES: Flush with cool water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. If irritation persists, call a physician or poison center.

SKIN: Wash with soap and plenty of water. If irritation persists, call a physician or poison center.

INHALATION: Remove to fresh air. If irritation persists, call a physician or poison control center.
