## Net Contents:

**Bacterial Drain Maintainer** is a blend of specific microbes selected for their ability to bio-degrade high volumes of grease including long-chain fatty acids which other products cannot break down. More importantly, this formulation provides grease control in drain lines, pipes and floor traps without using surfactants. The bio-degradation of the grease devours it and prevents it from simply being mobilized further down the drain.

The unique formulation of **Bacterial Drain Maintainer**:

- Contains patented gram-positive bacterial strains to bio-degrade long-chain fatty acids.
- Includes promicrobials which are capable of fast degradation of Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG).
- Has a pH range from 4.5 to 9.8.
- Works with an effective temperature range of 38° - 145°F and an optimal temperature range of 60° - 90°F.
- Maintains optimal FOG degradation through three-fold action.
- Has passed the EPA Methods 1664 and 1664A, proving the grease is not mobilized.
- Reduces odors.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN DRAIN LINES:

Treat drains for 3 to 7 days at start up.

Dose weekly with 2-4 oz. per drain trap, allowing to sit over night when possible for best results.

For long drain lines, dose with 4-8 oz. daily, adjusting the treatment level based on need.

**Recommendation:** To assure that your system is maintained as effectively and efficiently as possible, use a programmable peristaltic metering pump to automatically feed **Bacterial Drain Maintainer** into your drains as needed around the clock.
